Course Description:

Following the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks, the then-Office for Domestic Preparedness and other federal security agencies such as Department of Homeland Security were developed to deter the potential threat of terrorism. It was determined that a need for implementation of secure and concrete preparedness programs with training for terrorism awareness in the United States.

Homeland Security has now more than ever due to ISIS Islamic State of Iraq and Syria, been on its highest alert due to the current cyber security breaches and over 200 recent domestic terrorism acts of terror and threats. This course is an In-Depth, 16 hour introduction into one of the most important safety issues of our time. This course will enable the dispatcher to recognize certain key words upon call-taking, react accordingly to incoming calls of suspicious persons/activity.
