TRAINING COURSE: Available for those who dispatch and take fire related emergency calls: Supervisors – Dispatcher training personnel – Call Takers – Leads and Dispatchers.

This is a new course offered to public safety dispatchers responsible for receiving and dispatching fire related emergencies, to paid or volunteer fire Departments. Entering into CAD, documenting the call and working the following but not limited to critical incidents call. Call-taking for fire services, administration lines, or E-911 dispatching fire departments to – structural and non-structural fires. Hazmat and ICS

overview first responder and service related calls.

TOPICS WILL INCLUDE: Firefighter safety involving firefighter down – mayday! R.I.T. - FAST- RIC- PASS-SCBA-MOVE UP-MUTUAL AID - 2ND, 3RD Alarm. How to handle simulation calls for service and radio traffic effectively handling an ambush call.

- ** Tour of local fire department with apparatus overview & some hands on exercises for students attending on day 2.

Each student will be given course supplies, manual, handout manual- Which includes a mayday policy. Upon approval to incorporate, if you choose, for implementation in your agency.

Each student will receive a current (on CD) ERG Guide, Cameo Download, ALOHA and Marplott Download to utilize at work during a potential hazmat incident. They will also receive a copy of a LODD guideline manual to assist your agency in case of a fallen member of service and to help assist your agency in preparation of such details.

All students will have a table top scenario to work through on day one.

At the end of day two all students must participate in a team roll play scenario.
