Who should attend: All Public Safety Dispatchers, Supervisors, Leads and Police Officers working more than 8 hours on the console. All students must participate in role playing scenarios on day two.

Key Learning Objectives: This 16-hour course is designed to instruct the Emergency Telecommunicator by instruction and practical demonstrated roll play scenarios, and how to experience the world of the officer on the street. The current national standards for deployment, the nontraditional role of both dispatcher and officer interactions are instructed. Student will receive both aspects in this course as to the responsibilities of communications, and the role the officers take on site.

BEHIND THE BADGE

Day I: Instructional event has classroom studies on Mississippi Law as it relates to capital & felony crimes, followed with hands on studies of officer survival, and the principals of pursuit driving. Students attending the police pistol range to receive instruction from the NRA certified Range Masters. Students will shoot the short course during this period of instruction.

Day II: Students will be given hands on instruction using simunitions training, and participate in Scenario Based Roll Playing. Students will be able to participate in several types of police vehicle exercises supplemented with the use of simunitions. The material is reinforced through interactive instruction, video, handout material and a Q&A period. The course is designed to be intense and to leave the student with a new perspective on our rolls in Public Safety.

Students who wish to bring their own firearm must supply their own ammo. We have Glock 9s for the class, and only supply ammo for the firearms we provide during instruction.

Instructors supply orange vests for scenarios, protective eye goggles, and ear plugs for each student

Students are required to comply with the instructor's rules when utilizing police vehicle during scenario
