Length: 4 Days (32 Hours)

Designed For: This course is designed for working, certified K-9 Handlers and their Drug Detector Dog who are full time law enforcement or military personnel.



Prerequisites: K-9 team MUST have a prior narcotics detector certification. This certification may be from any certifying entity. Proof of certification must be provided with application. Military personnel must have approval from chain of command to attend.

Course Description:

This course is designed for working, certified K-9 Handlers and their Drug Detector Dog who are full time law enforcement or military personnel.

Course Objectives:

- Evaluation
- Training records
- Detection training
- Search strategies
- Distractions
- Scent preparation

Handlers and dogs will work in a wide variety of environments and scenarios to include vehicles, buildings, persons, etc. Fully secure, clean, industry standards kennels are located on the RCTA complex. Each handler is required to bring his animal's food, leather gear, and any personal training equipment needed.

Be advised your dog will be housed with eleven other dogs in an indoor air-conditioned kennel. No provision exists for keeping your dog in the barracks.
