Who should attend: All Public Safety Dispatchers, Supervisors, Leads and Police Officers working more than 8 hours as an E-Telecommunicator.

All students can participate in role playing and tabletop scenarios on day two.

This course is a 16-hour introduction to the troubling acts of violence taking place not only within our schools but our workplaces as well. The course provides history, as well as insights from those events that have already occurred. Current national standards for deployments and swat interactions are instructed. Student will receive both aspects in this course as to the responsibilities of communications, and the role the officers take on site. From those lessons learned the emergency Telecommunicator is given current plans of action so that they may prepare to handle such an event. The instructional material is reinforced through classroom which is designed to prepare the student to react in a timely and professional manner. Thus, it will provide them with confidence to handle these types of critical incidents. It is also designed to be intense and to leave the student with a new perspective on our roles in Public Safety.

Key Learning Objectives:

Current national standards for deployment. The nontraditional role, and seat interactions are instructed. Student will receive both aspects in this course as to the responsibilities of communications, and the role the officers take on site.
