On April 23, 2026, Harrison County Sheriff Matt Haley announced the seizure of 6.6 pounds of cocaine during a traffic stop on Interstate 10.

On April 22, 2026, at approximately 1:33 PM, a Deputy from the Harrison County Sheriff's Office Criminal Interdiction Division conducted a traffic stop on a Nissan Altima at the 36-mile marker of Interstate 10 eastbound in Gulfport. During the stop, Deputies made contact with the driver, who identified herself as Amy Broadt from Fort Walton Beach, Florida. During the course of the traffic stop a K9 alerted on the vehicle. During a probable cause search of the vehicle Deputies located 6.6 pounds of cocaine within a bag in the trunk.

Harrison County Narcotics Investigators responded and took over the Investigation. Broadt was booked into the Harrison County jail and charged with Aggravated Trafficking cocaine with a \$250,000 bond per Judge Albert Fountain.
