On Saturday, March 16, 2025, Harrison County Sheriff Matt Haley announced the arrest of three individuals on felony drug trafficking charges following a traffic stop and search warrant. During the stop and search warrant, Investigators recovered approximately (88) pounds of bulk marijuana and multiple firearms. Subsequently, Terence Benard Benjamin (26), Isiah James Smith (24) and Marvin Bryan Brumfield (32) of Biloxi were each charged with a felony charge of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance, Marijuana.

On Friday, March 14, 2025, Harrison County Narcotics Task Force Investigators conducted a traffic stop on a Dodge Charger on Shriners Blvd. near Village Dr. in Biloxi. Investigators made contact with Benjamin, Smith and Brumfield and recovered a small quantity of marijuana. A probable cause search of the vehicle ensued leading to the discovery of a handgun and approximately (70) pounds of bulk marijuana concealed in the trunk.

Harrison County Narcotics Task Force Investigators furthered the investigation to a residence in the 2000 block of Trailwood Drive in Biloxi leading to the execution of a search warrant. Inside the residence, Investigators located approximately (18) additional pounds of bulk marijuana, (3) rifles and paraphernalia indicative of drug distribution. Benjamin, Smith and Brumfield were arrested and transported to the Harrison County Jail to each be held in lieu of a \$250,000.00 bond set by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Albert J. Fountain.
